“He will help you go the right way.”

READ:

Proverbs 3: 5-7 (ERV)

5 Trust the Lord completely, and don't depend on your own knowledge. 6 With every step you take, think about what he wants, and he will help you go the right way. 7 Don't trust in your own wisdom, but fear and respect the Lord and stay away from evil.

Psalms 128 1: (MSG)

All you who fear God, how blessed you are! How happily you walk on his smooth straight road!

Think about the path of your life, the twists and turns along a winding path that represent times you leaned on your own understanding. Think about how those moments were led by a proud heart [pride], haughty eyes [ambition], and focused on things too great and awesome [arrogance]. Do you remember when you stopped trusting in your own wisdom and chose to follow Jesus.

As you reflect on your life's journey, allow God to invigorate your creative juices. Create the map of your life with all the twists, turns, and straight paths.
